The Spiritual Gifts and Their Definitions

Administration: Strong organizational skills and the ability to assist a leader by noticing and handling details and keeping the church on course. This person works closely with a leader and has some leadership and management skills, but is less visionary than one with the gift of leadership, though he can give significant input into plans. (1 Cor.12:28; Luke 14:28-30; Titus 1:5)

Apostle/Missionary: The ability to effectively share the gospel and further God's Kingdom often in place away from your home or in a culture different from your own. This often includes planting and establishing new local churches. (1 Cor. 9:19-23; 12:28; Ephesians 4:11)

Celibacy: The ability to enjoy remaining single in order to have more time and resources to serve God. (1 Corinthians 7:7; Matthew 19:12)

Discernment: The ability to sense whether something is right or wrong, good or evil, of God or of Satan. This includes an ability to sense whether someone's motives are pure and an ability to distinguish truth from error. (1 Corinthians 12:10; Acts 16:16-18; Hebrews 5:14; 1 John 4:1-6)

Encouragement/exhortation: The ability to comfort, encourage and build up others as well as to warn them and urge them to deal with areas of concern in their lives. (Romans 12:8; Acts 4:36; Acts 11:22-23)

Evangelism: The ability to share the gospel with unbelievers in such a way that people become followers of Christ. (Acts 21:8; Ephesians 4:11, 2 Timothy 4:5; 1 Cor. 1:17)

Faith: An extraordinary confidence and trust in God's ability to work and provide, even when it seems impossible to others. This often involves praying for big requests and seeing God answer. (1 Cor. 12:9; Matthew 17:20; 21:21-22; Mark 11:24; Hebrews 11)

Giving: An eagerness to give more than a tithe of your money to God's work or to people in need, and a willingness to cheerfully live with less in order to share your material things with others. (Romans 12:8; Acts 2:45; Acts 4:36-37; Philippians 4:15-19; 2 Cor. 8:1-5; 2 Cor. 9:7)

Healing: The ability to ask God for healing of disease or injury and to frequently see it happen, resulting in God being glorified and people coming to faith. (1 Cor. 12:9, 28; Acts 3:1-10; James 5:14-16)

Hospitality: A willingness to provide food and lodging for other believers in a way that makes them feel welcome and meets their needs. A desire to cook food or open your home to be used for God's purposes. (Romans 12:13; 1 Peter 4:9; Hebrews 13:2; 1 Timothy 3:2; Titus 1:8; 3 John 5-8)

Intercession: An unusual desire to pray for the needs of others and an effectiveness in seeing frequent and specific answers to prayer. (Eph 1:15-16; 1 Thes 3:10; 1 Tim 2:1-2)

Knowledge: When God allows a person to supernaturally know facts that they have not acquired by normal means, as when Jesus knew how many husbands the woman at the well had had. (1 Cor. 12:8; John 4:17-19; Matthew 12:25)

Leadership: The ability to vision and discern goals for a group of believers and then to motivate and lead them toward accomplishing those goals. One whom others are willing to follow. (Romans 12:8; Hebrews 13:7; Acts 15:13ff)

Mercy: The ability to feel genuine empathy and compassion for those who are weak, poor, suffering or in distress and to cheerfully do acts of love and kindness toward them. (Romans 12:8; Luke 10:30-37)

Miracles: A person through whom God chooses to perform supernatural and powerful acts in order to draw people to faith in Christ. A person who often sees miracles occur when they pray for them. (1 Cor. 12:10, 28; Acts 5:19; Acts 8:6; James 5:17-18)

Pastor: The ability and desire to care for the spiritual needs of other believers, helping them through life crises by guiding them to relevant Scriptures and praying with them. This includes a concern to guard a group of Christians from potential dangers and an eagerness to meet their need for spiritual nourishment, like a shepherd cares for sheep. (Acts 20:18-38; Ephesians 4:11; 1 Timothy 3:1-7; 1 Peter 5:1-4)

Prophecy: The ability to receive messages from God and to effectively communicate them to His people. This is not always predicting the future, although it can be. More often it is proclamation or preaching. (1 Cor. 12:10, 28; 1 Cor. 14:3-5, 31; Romans 12:6; Ephesians 4:11; 1 Peter 4:11; 2 Peter 1:19-21)

Service/Helps: The ability to assist others by cheerfully doing routine tasks in order to free up Christian leaders to focus on spiritual areas of ministry. This often includes an ability to notice what tasks need to be done and a willingness to jump in and do the job without coercion. (Romans 12:7, 1 Cor. 12:28; Acts 6:1-7; 1 Peter 4:11; 2 Tim. 1:16-18)

Teaching: The ability to pass on information, especially Biblical truths, so that others learn and understand it. The test of good teaching is not what the teacher knows; it's what the learner grasps. (Romans 12:7, 1 Cor. 12:28; Hebrews 5:12; Ephesians 4:11)

Tongues: The supernatural ability to speak in a language that you have never learned. Tongues can be used in private worship, or tongues can be used in a public gathering to receive and communicate a message from God to His people. The language spoken is sometimes an actual human language, or it can be divinely-given language that is not spoken anywhere on earth. (1 Cor. 12:10, 28-31; 13:1; 14:1-40)

Interpretation of Tongues: The ability to interpret the message of one who has spoken in tongues, translating it into a language that the local Body of Christ can understand. (1 Cor. 12:10, 30; 1 Cor. 14:13, 26-28)

Wisdom: The ability to apply Biblical truths to practical life, and the ability to guide people toward finding solutions to problems and toward knowing which direction to go when they are at times of decision. (1 Cor. 12:8; Acts 15:13-20)
