

# '10 Summer Camp

## **Rules:**

- **Stay clean.** No using or bringing drugs, alcohol, cigars, cigarettes or chewing tobacco
- **Respect others.** No punching, kicking, biting, scratching, pulling hair.
- **Only use Personal Electronic Devices and cell phones when permitted.** PEDs/cell phones are only allowed on the trip to camp and on the way home. You are not permitted to use PEDs/cell phones at camp. If PEDs/cell phones are used outside your room at camp, you need to surrender it to the leader and it will be returned to you at the end of the day. The second time it is seen outside your room, it will be returned to you when we leave camp.
- **Cleanliness is good☺.** No getting relaxed in your normal activities such as but not limited to: brushing, showering, the use of deodorizing agents or any practice similar to these.
- **Attend all meetings and worship experiences.** No missing, skipping, being late for, sleeping through or acting rude during any of the meetings & worship times. If you are feeling sick, please notify Jon, Dustin, or Kasey prior to the event.
- **Keep Red and Blue separate.** No “Public Displays of Affection”, procreating, or any activity that gives the impression or leads to possible procreation.
- **Stay on the church and camp property.** No exploring, adventuring, treasure hunting, leaving any area we are supposed to be as a group
- **Respect the property.** No food flights, tag team wrestling with a ring made of mattresses, drilling holes, playing homerun derby, darts or removing articles from your room in your room. Limited snacks and drinks are allowed on the bus. Drinks must have screw top lids. Students must put **all** garbage in the garbage bags on the bus. Any damage to your room, bus, or other property will be billed to parents.
- **Respect our leaders and camp leaders.** No disrespecting of authority, rank, dignity or self worth to any leader or student on our trip. Come with high expectations of God, yourself and others, so we can all have a great time!
- **Drink lots of water.** No energy drinks are allowed on this trip.
- **Be on time.** To help us reach our destinations in a timely manner, students are to be back to the bus at the assigned times. Students who are late will be fined 50 cents per minute they are late. This money will be given to Compassion International.
